Fun Event for Electric Launched Sailplanes

FRIDAY 19th FEBRUARY

Processing begins at 2:30 and Flying commences as soon
as all entries are processed.

You may enter up until noon on the 19th.

For Old-timers to Hot-liners

This is a fun event! Entry fee is \$1, and the entry fees will be the prize money down to 5th place.

The basic rules are:

Event consists of 3 rounds of "Man on Man"

THERE WILL BE NO RECHARGING BETWEEN ROUNDS.

This is an LMR event with run time determined by the watts/pound of the model. Models will be weighed, and power checked by a 5 second motor run before the first round.

Battery must be accessible for a 'WHATTMETER' to be connected for power check, using "Deans" connectors.

If other connectors are used please provide your own WATT-meter.

The target flight time of 10 minutes each round will INCLUDE the motor run.

Motor run will be determined at model processing and marked on the model, the scorecard, and TX with a sticky label.

Entry is divided in to groups A and B. Group A will time for B and B will time for A.

Just as an example, a floater with a power to weight of 50 Watts / pound may be allowed a motor run of 60 seconds, but a Hot-Liner with a power to weight of 500Watts per pound may be allowed a motor run of only 3 seconds.

Landings will be simple in/out for 20 points, and the circle will be LARGE!
